## **Description of Weekly Activities**

### **Spring Semester (Jan –April)**

#### **1. Prayers**

Prayers (Iqama) are fixed for the period of one month. Salat-ul-Jumu'ah is set for 1:15 pm through out the year.

#### **2. Qur'an Recitation: Daily 6:15–6:30 am**

Daily Quran halaqa after Fajr prayer. General reading and fluency practice with no rules enforcement.

#### **3. Arabic 101: Monday 6:30-8:30 pm [Imam Abdullatif]**

Arabic 101: This is an introductory class to the Arabic alphabet for adults (men & women). Registration and regular attendance is mandatory. (\$150 plus \$25 registration and books fees per semester)

#### **4. Aikido Class: Wednesday 5:30-6:30 pm for children [Br. Sharif]**

Martial art class for children age 5 to 14. Registration and proper uniform are mandatory. (\$120 per semester plus \$30 for uniform).

#### **5. Quran Tajweed Class: Thursday 6:30-7:30 pm [Imam Abdullatif]**

A focused class for Qur'an recitation and Tajweed rules. No fee for the class but regular attendance is a must.

#### **6. Soccer Game: Friday 5:30-7:00 [Br. Fathy, Br. Tarek, Br. Hashim, Br. Omar]**

Game practice at Patch Reef Park soccer fields with occasional games on Sunday Morning. Proper uniform is required. (\$80 per semester plus \$40 for soccer uniform)

#### **7. Boy Scouts Meeting: Saturday 6:00-7:30 pm [Br. Iyad]**

Boy Scout is a program for boys and young adults to build character, to train in the responsibilities of participating citizenship, and to develop personal fitness.

The Islamic Center of Boca Raton has a Cub Scout Pack for young children (1st-5th grade) and a Boy Scout Troop (6th grade-18 years old). Pack and Troop 394 meet on Saturdays at 6:00 pm. Parents are also invited to share activities with their sons. (\$30 Annual fee registration with Boy Scout of America plus activities fee apply).

#### **8. Girl Scouts Meeting: Saturday 6:00-7:30 pm [Sister Veronica]**

ICBR provides under the Girl Scouts of the USA a program for our young sisters to build character and skills for success in the real world. In partnership with committed adult volunteer sisters, girls develop qualities that will serve them all their lives, like leadership, strong values, social conscience, and conviction about their own potential and self-worth. (\$30 Annual fee registration plus activities fee apply)

#### **9. Family Social Night: Saturday 6:30-9:00 pm**

The family night is a night of learning, education, and socialization among the community members. It is ICBR's intention and goal to service its community with the best information about various areas of interest and concerns and to foster Islamic principles among children and adults. Keynote speakers are occasionally invited, check the Masjid web site at [www.icbr.org](http://www.icbr.org) for scheduled speakers. Dinners are occasionally served as to celebrate special events such as Aqiqa, graduation, marriage, well fairs, etc.

#### **10. Weekend Islamic School: Sunday 10-30 am-2:00 pm**

ICBR offers a Sunday school for student ages 4-14, (kindergarten to 8th grade). The program encompasses teaching Qur'an, Arabic language and Islamic Studies (Aqeedah, Fiqh, Sirah, etc..) The Spring Semester runs from January 13 until May 18. The semester fee is \$300.

#### **11. Basketball Practice: Sunday 4:00-6:00 pm (Br. Abdurahman)**

Game practice for teenage boys age 13 and up. No fees. Proper uniform is required.
